



## **IMPORTANT UPDATE FOR TRAVELING TO THE US**

### **US entry requirements have changed**

The U.S. government has announced that effective Monday, December 6, all air passengers, regardless of vaccination status, must show a negative Covid-19 test taken no more than 1 day before travel to the United States. For reference, the official CDC update is [\*\*HERE\*\*](#).

As always, we wish to reassure travelers that Saint Lucia can confidently assure they will have access to departure Covid tests. For visitors returning to the US, we suggest checking with your accommodation provider, as most of our hotels and villas assist with scheduling on-site testing. Other requirements already in effect to note:

You must be fully vaccinated to travel to the United States by plane if you are a non-U.S. citizen, non-U.S. immigrant (not a U.S. citizen, U.S. national, lawful permanent resident, or traveling to the United States on an immigrant visa). Only limited exceptions apply.

You are required to show a negative COVID-19 test result or documentation of recovery from COVID-19 when you travel to the United States by air.
